SINGLE STAGE MASTERS RACE SPECIFIC REGULATION

Article 1 – Description

1.1 The Single Stage Masters Race is open for registration for non-UCI licensed participants, amateurs and local teams.

1.2 It is open for individual and team competition.

Article 2 – Race Categories

2.1 Categories are as follows:

- Men's Master A (Age 20 - 29)
- Men's Master B (Age 30 - 39)
- Men's Master C (Age 40 - 49)
- Women's Open (Age 20 - 35)

Article 3 – Age and Eligibility

3.1 Age will be based on the UCI rule wherein a participant's age is determined by the age he/she will reach this year.

3.2 Participants also must have not joined any UCI race within the past five (5) years.

Article 4 – Race Distance

4.1 Race distance is 50 kilometers from the starting line to the finish line.

Article 5 – Allowed equipment

5.1 Only road bicycles are allowed in this category.

Article 6 – Schedules and Venue

6.1 Event date is on May 26, 2019 at Harbor Point in Subic, Zambales.

6.2 Time of start is 11:00 a.m.

Article 7 – Awards

7.1 The following recognitions will be awarded:

Male awards

- Top 5 Individuals
- Top 3 Teams
- King of the Mountain
- Sprint King

Female awards

- Top 3 Individuals
- Queen of the Mountain
- Sprint Queen

Article 8 – Conduct of Riders

8.1 General principles of sportsmanship are expected from all riders.

8.2 Dangerous and reckless riding, foul language, sexist, discriminatory and violent behaviors will not be tolerated.

8.3 Riders involved in intermediate and final sprints shall stick to their own lane and will be closely monitored for the proper conduct of the sprint.

8.4 Be respectful and mindful of other people and the environment.

8.5 Riders may not, without due care, jettison food, bonk-bags, feeding bottles, clothes, etc. in any place whatsoever.

8.6 Riders may not jettison anything on the roadway itself but shall draw to the side of the road and safely deposit the object there.

8.7 If waste zones are established by the organizer, the rider must safely and exclusively deposit their waste on the sides of the road in this area.

8.8 Carrying and/or using glass objects are not allowed.

8.9 No support vehicles (4 wheels/ 2 wheels) will be allowed.

Article 9 – Settlements

9.1 Any and all complaints, queries, protests and grievances are to be directed to the immediate Race Officials on the day of the event and are best to be settled before egress.

9.2 Other matters before or after the event shall be extended in writing and addressed to the organizers listed below (Article 10).
